Annual Meeting Minutes

June 28, 2014

Called to Order by President Art Weaver at 9:00 am. Over 100 people in attendance.

Presidents report from Art Weaver: Expressed appreciation for membership and dues. Provided an update on projects over the past year and requested volunteers to become involved.

Jodi Eberhardt, Vice President, introduced guest speakers regarding current projects and concerns:

- DNR update from Mike Duval, District Manager: Update on nesting colony at Gooseberry Island including gulls, cormorants, and lack of arctic tern nests this year. Gave overview of zebra mussel sampling and new research on genetic sampling.
- DNR update from Heather Baird, Aquatic Habitat Specialist: Overview of cisco deep water lake protection needs and late summer squeeze on deep water fish. Discussed opportunities for protection and keeping land forested.
- Water Quality/Well Testing update from Sarah Fogderud, AW Research Project Manager: Provided an update on eColi beach testing results, well testing results, and groundwater testing project.

Breezy Point police provided information on public safety – including available classes on hands only CPR.

Treasurer, Craig Norman, provided an overview on financial status including spending analysis by types of initiatives.

Committee reports provided for: Beach Captains, Newsletter, AIS Landing Monitors, and Membership.

Elections held: Joe Ayers elected not to remain on the board. Art Weaver, Rick Nolan, Dave Slipy, Bob Hamilton, and Matt Stephens were re-elected for a two-year term. Jodi Billy, Lori Greeno, and Jim Nickel were added to the board for a two-year term.
